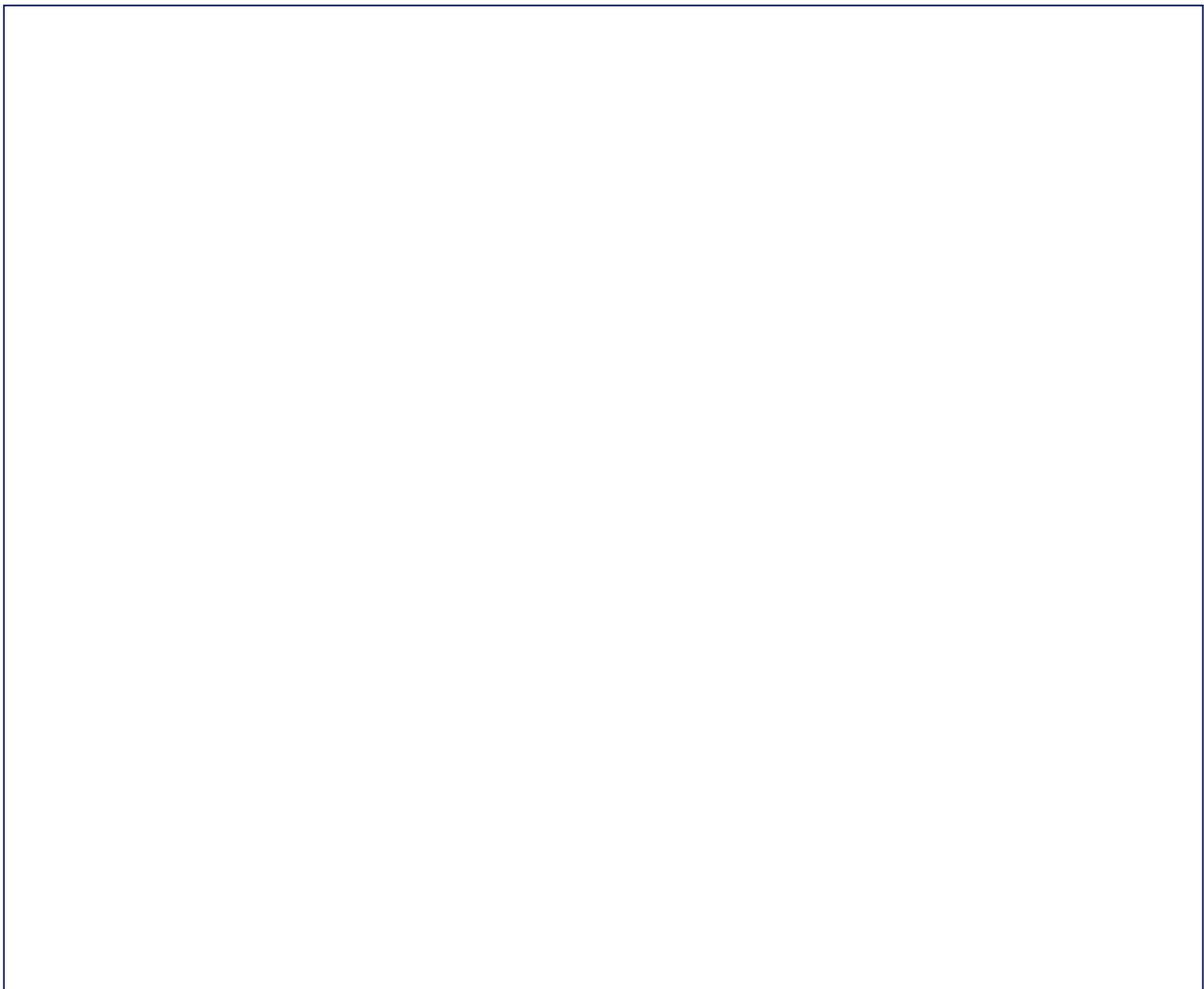


My Favourite Book Review

Draw: Draw a large, detailed picture of the most exciting scene from your chosen book in the box provided. Use bright colours and include the main character. Make sure the background shows where the story is happening (the setting). Add labels to show who the characters are and what is happening in the scene.
