Learning objective: To use descriptive language and simple sentences to retell a festive story and answer comprehension questions.

Read the sentences carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell tricky words. Write your answers in full sentences.

Pip the caterpillar and Max the monkey went for a walk on a cold winter evening. They saw a tree with twinkling lights. They decided to leave a gift of fresh fruit under the tree to show kindness to their forest friends. It was a perfect way to celebrate the holiday.

2. What did Pip and Max see that was twinkling? (1 mark)

3. Why did Pip and Max leave a gift of fruit under the tree? (2 marks)

4. Can you write a sentence describing what the winter snow looks like? (2 marks)

5. If you had £5 to buy a small gift for a friend, what would you buy and why? (2 marks)
