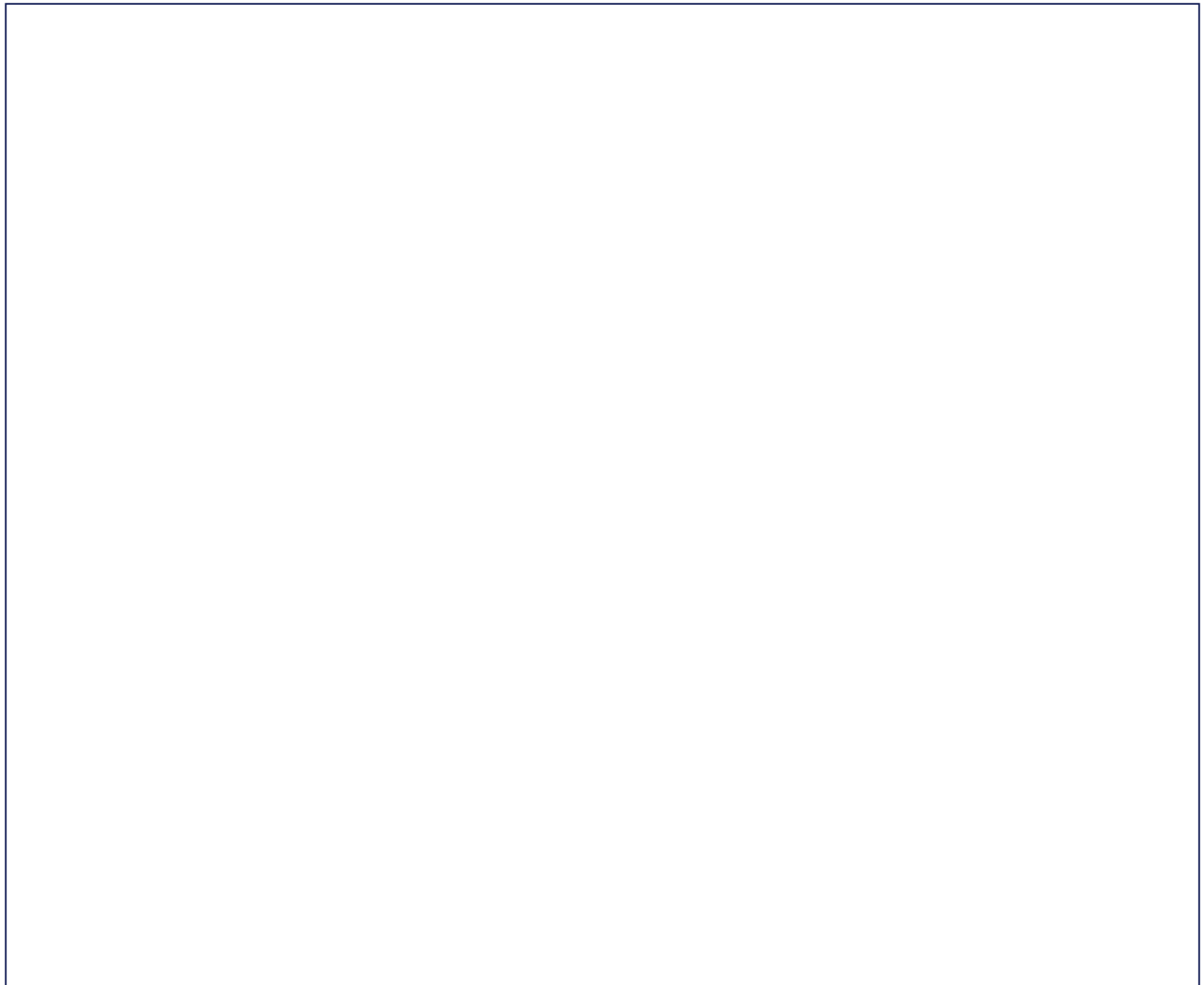


Leo the Lion's Christmas Eve Adventure

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and artistic expression to retell a Christmas scene.

Read the scene below and follow the instructions to create your own Christmas illustration. Use your best handwriting for the labels.

Draw: Draw a large scene showing Leo the Lion in the centre of a snowy forest. Use a pencil to sketch his golden mane and his red scarf. In the background, draw tall pine trees covered in snow. In the sky, draw many bright, twinkling stars. Add the glowing lantern in Leo's paw and the festive wreath near the base of the largest tree. Use bright colours for the lantern and the wreath to make them stand out.



Label words: starry sky · glowing lantern · woolly scarf · festive wreath · snowy forest · golden mane

Steps:

1. What is Leo wearing to keep warm in the forest?
2. Why does Leo need a lantern in the forest?
3. Describe the sky in this story using one adjective from the word bank.
4. Draw a line from the label 'festive wreath' to the item Leo is carrying.
5. If you were joining Leo, what special item would you bring to the forest?
