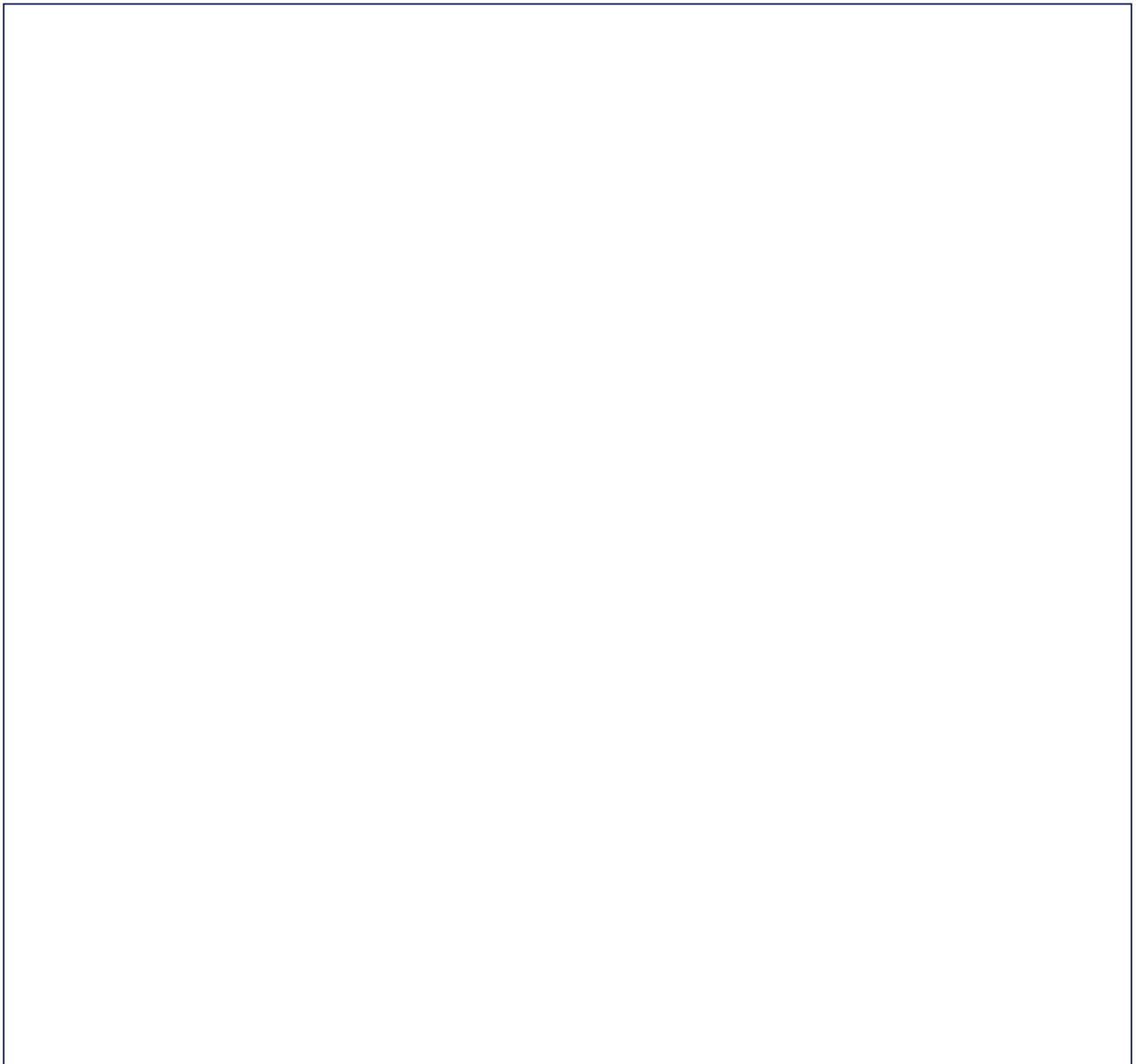


Pip's Story Garden

Learning objective: To encourage creative writing and mark-making by associating illustrations with storytelling.

Help Pip the caterpillar bring his story to life! Colour in the garden scene and write a short sentence or draw a picture in the blank speech bubble to show what Pip is writing about in his notebook.

Colour this: A large, friendly caterpillar named Pip wearing a tiny pair of glasses. Pip is sitting on a large, bold-lined sunflower, holding a small open notebook and a pencil.
