Learning objective: To write clear, imaginative sentences using capital letters, full stops, and descriptive adjectives.

Read the sentences carefully. Use your best handwriting and remember your punctuation. Look at the word bank if you need help with your spelling.

Max the monkey and Zara the zebra went for a walk in the deep, green woods. They found a shiny, golden key hidden under a large leaf. Max picked it up and they wondered what it might open.

2. What did Max and Zara find under the leaf? (2 marks)

3. Add a descriptive adjective from the word bank to this sentence: The monkey jumped over the _____ log. (2 marks)

4. Write a sentence using the word 'sparkling'. Remember your capital letter and full stop. (3 marks)

5. Why do you think Max and Zara were excited to find the key? Write two reasons. (4 marks)

6. Imagine the golden key opens a secret wooden door in the forest. Write 3-4 sentences about what they see when they open the door. Think about what is inside and how it makes them feel. (12 marks)
