

My Magical Character Profile: A Guide by Kit the Fox

Learning objective: To use expanded noun phrases and descriptive adjectives to create a detailed character for a story.

Kit the Fox is working on a new mystery story and needs your help! Use this template to invent a brand-new character. Think about how they look, what they enjoy doing, and what makes them special. Use the word bank to help you add extra detail to your sentences.

Word bank: mysterious · shimmering · enormous · courageous · cheerful · glistening · tangled · vibrant · ancient · speedy

1. Character Name and Appearance: Choose a name for your character. Describe their physical features, such as their hair, eyes, or clothing. Use at least two adjectives. (2 marks)

2. Character Personality: Is your character kind, grumpy, shy, or brave? Explain how they act when they are around their friends. (2 marks)

3. Special Talents: What is your character excellent at doing? Do they have a secret skill or a magical ability? (2 marks)

4. Favourite Possession: What is one item your character always carries with them? Describe what it looks like. (2 marks)

5. The Character's Goal: What is one thing your character really wants to achieve or find in their adventure? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph describing your character entering a forest. Use an expanded noun phrase, such as 'the towering, emerald trees' or 'the soft, golden sunlight'.
