

Springtime with Pip and the Easter Garden

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills through colouring and engage with the themes of spring and new beginnings.

Colour in the picture carefully. Use bright, spring colours for the flowers and the butterfly. Once you have finished, use the labels to point out the different parts of the garden.

Colour this: A peaceful garden scene. In the centre, Pip the cheerful caterpillar is wearing a little sun hat and smiling. Surrounding Pip are three large, decorated Easter eggs with different patterns (stripes, spots, and zig-zags). There are tall daffodils and tulips growing in the background. A friendly butterfly with large, patterned wings is hovering near the top right. The lines should be bold and clear for a Year 1 child to colour easily.



Steps:

1. Label the butterfly in your picture.
2. Label the flowers in your picture.
