

Springtime Stories with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To understand the key events of the Easter story and develop reading comprehension skills.

Read the story below with a partner or an adult. Then, use your best handwriting to answer the questions about the text.

Ellie the Elephant loves to visit the old, stone library to read stories from long ago. Today, she is sharing the Easter story. A long time ago, a man named Jesus travelled to Jerusalem. People waved palm leaves to welcome him because they were happy to see him. Later, the story tells us about a time of great sadness, but then a wonderful surprise happened. On the first Easter morning, his friends found that the tomb was empty. They were filled with joy and hope. Today, many people celebrate Easter by giving eggs, which are a sign of new life in the spring. Ellie says it is a time to be kind and remember that hope is a beautiful thing.

5. Can you name one way you can show kindness to a friend this spring? (1 mark)
