Learning objective: To recall key events and symbols associated with the Easter story, suitable for Year 2 pupils.

Read the front of the card to guess the word or answer. Turn the card over (or check the answer below) to see if you are correct. Can you think of a sentence for each word?

What is the name of the day when people celebrate the start of Easter week by waving palm leaves?

Palm Sunday

Which gentle animal is often mentioned in the Easter story as carrying a rider into the city?

A donkey

What do we call the Sunday that marks the end of the Easter story and is a time for celebration?

Easter Sunday

Pip the caterpillar knows that Easter happens in which season, when flowers start to bloom?

Spring

Ellie the elephant remembers that the Easter story is often linked to the feeling of having a bright future. What is this called?

Hope

If a group of friends have a special party or feast, what is that called?

A celebration

What do chicks, eggs, and budding flowers represent during the Easter season?

New life

When we think quietly about our actions and feelings, what is this called?

Reflection

What do we call the act of being friendly, generous, and caring towards others?

Kindness

When someone travels from one place to another, like characters in a story, what do we call it?

A journey
