

Grammar Explorer Flashcards with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and use key grammatical terms including nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, and sentence types as per the Year 2 National Curriculum.

Use these flashcards to test your knowledge! Max the Monkey loves to solve puzzles. Read the front of the card, try to answer, then check the answer on the back.

What is a Noun?

A noun is a word that names a person, place, or thing (e.g., Max, garden, banana).

What is a Verb?

A verb is an action word or a 'doing' word (e.g., jump, eat, climb).

What is an Adjective?

An adjective is a word that describes a noun (e.g., the clever monkey, the yellow banana).

What is an Adverb?

An adverb describes how an action is done, often ending in -ly (e.g., Max climbed quickly).

What is a Statement?

A statement tells the reader information and ends with a full stop.

What is a Question?

A question asks something and ends with a question mark (?).

What is a Command?

A command gives an instruction or an order (e.g., 'Eat your lunch.').

What is an Exclamation?

An exclamation expresses strong feeling and ends with an exclamation mark (!).

What is a Suffix?

A suffix is a group of letters added to the end of a word to change its meaning (e.g., -ed, -ing, -ful).

What is a Prefix?

A prefix is a group of letters added to the start of a word to change its meaning (e.g., un-, re-).

What is a Conjunction?

A conjunction joins two words or sentences together (e.g., and, but, or, so).

What is an Apostrophe for possession?

An apostrophe shows that something belongs to someone (e.g., Max's banana).
