- A statement tells you a fact. Example: Max likes to count the shiny apples.
- A command tells someone to do something. Example: Please sort these colourful patterns.
- A question asks for information and ends with a question mark. Example: Where is Zara hiding?
- An exclamation shows strong feeling and often starts with 'What' or 'How'. Example: What a beautiful garden this is!

Did you know? Did you know? Every sentence needs a capital letter at the start and a punctuation mark at the end to help the reader know when to pause or stop!
