

My Character Profile: Meeting Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To practise forming letters correctly, maintaining consistent size, and using capital letters and full stops for simple sentences.

Today, we are practising our handwriting by writing about Max the Monkey. Look at the word bank for help with your spelling. Use your best handwriting, making sure your tall letters (like l, h, t) reach the top of the line and your 'tail' letters (like g, p, y) sit below the line. Remember to use a capital letter at the start of your sentence and a full stop at the end.

Word bank: Max · monkey · maths · puzzles · clever · jungle · happy · fast

1. Name and Appearance: Write a sentence about what Max looks like. Remember your capital letter and full stop. (2 marks)

2. Favourite Activity: Write a sentence explaining what Max loves to do. Use the word 'maths' in your answer. (2 marks)

3. Personality: Write a sentence describing what kind of friend Max is. (2 marks)

4. The Puzzle: If Max found a puzzle with 5 pieces and 3 more pieces, how many pieces would he have? Write your answer as a full sentence. (2 marks)

5. Extra Detail: Write one more interesting fact about Max the Monkey. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write a short poem about Max? Try to use at least one word from the word bank and make sure your letters are sitting neatly on the line.
