Learning objective: To identify, classify, and use nouns and verbs correctly in sentences.

Read each question carefully. Use your best handwriting and remember to check your work for capital letters and full stops.

Max the monkey lives in the green jungle. Every morning, he wakes up and climbs the tallest tree. He finds a yellow banana for his breakfast. Max is very happy.

1. Look at the passage. Find two nouns (naming words) and write them below. (2 marks)

2. Look at the passage. Find two verbs (action words) and write them below. (2 marks)

3. Circle the nouns in this list: apple, run, table, skip, teacher, sing. (3 marks)

4. Add a suitable verb to complete this sentence: Pip the caterpillar _____ a book. (2 marks)

5. Write a sentence of your own about Nova the owl. Your sentence must include one noun and one verb. Underline the noun and circle the verb. (4 marks)

6. Read this sentence: 'The busy bee flies to the flower.' Change the verb to a different action word and rewrite the sentence. Then, change the noun 'flower' to a different place and rewrite it again. (4 marks)

7. Write a short story (3-5 sentences) about Finn the dolphin playing in the sea. Use at least three nouns and three verbs. Remember to use capital letters and full stops. (8 marks)
