

Mastering Nouns and Verbs with Max and Pip

Learning objective: To identify, classify, and use nouns and verbs accurately within sentences.

Read each question carefully. Use your knowledge of word classes to help Max the monkey and Pip the caterpillar complete their word puzzles.

1. Max the monkey is sorting his word collection. From the word bank provided, list all the nouns (things, places, or creatures) in one column and all the verbs (actions) in another. (4 marks)

2. Rewrite the following sentence by replacing the verb 'walk' with a more descriptive verb from the word bank: 'The monkey decided to walk through the jungle.' (2 marks)

3. Identify the noun and the verb in this sentence: 'Pip reads a story.' Write them down clearly. (2 marks)

4. Write a complex sentence about an adventure that includes at least two nouns and two verbs. Underline your nouns and circle your verbs. (3 marks)

5. Explain why the word 'climb' can be a verb, but 'mountain' cannot. Use an example to support your answer. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey sitting in a tree and Pip the caterpillar reading a book nearby. Label two nouns and two verbs in your drawing.



Extension challenge: Choose three verbs from the word bank and write them in the past, present, and future tense to show how the action changes over time.
