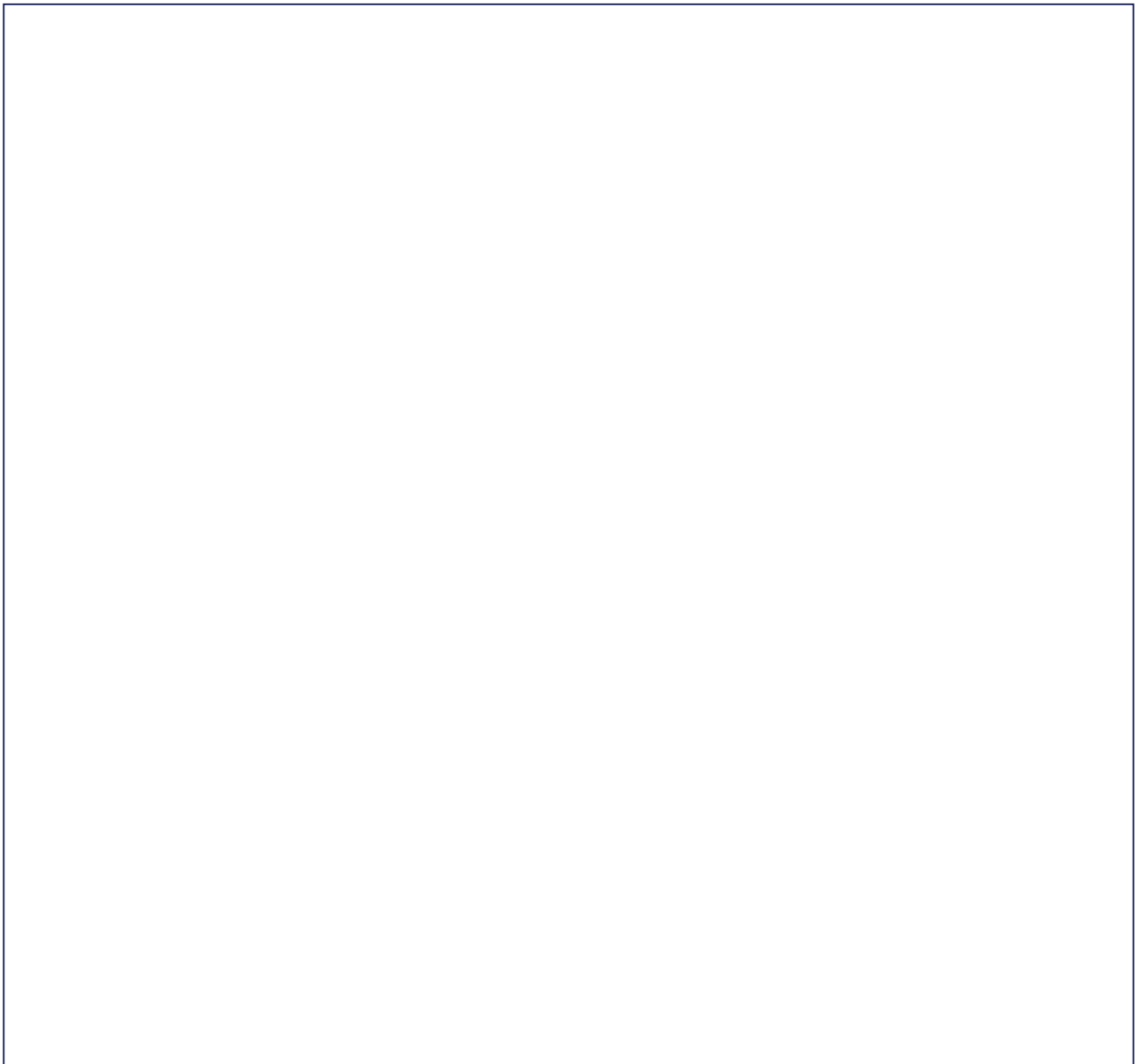


Leo's Poetry Garden

Learning objective: To identify and explore the features of a poem while engaging in creative expression.

Read the fun facts about poetry, then colour in the scene. Use your best colours to bring the garden to life!

Colour this: A friendly lion named Leo sitting under a large, leafy oak tree in a sunny garden. Leo is wearing a small waistcoat and holding a scroll of parchment with a quill pen. Surrounding him are several large, colourful flowers with petals shaped like musical notes or stars. One flower has the word 'RHYME' written on a leaf.
