

Pip the Caterpillar's Garden Adventure

Learning objective: To develop reading comprehension skills by recalling key details, predicting events, and discussing character feelings in a story context.

Read the story provided by your teacher about Pip the caterpillar. Use your best phonics skills to help you answer the questions below. Remember to look for clues in the pictures and the words!

Pip is a small, green caterpillar who lives in a big, colourful garden. Pip loves to read books under a giant oak leaf. One sunny morning, Pip felt very hungry. He wiggled his body and crawled to the vegetable patch to find a crunchy snack. He found a bright red strawberry that cost 50p at the garden market. Pip shared the strawberry with his friend, Max the monkey. They both felt very happy and sat together to read a story about the stars.

1. What is the name of the caterpillar in our story? (1 mark)

2. Where does Pip like to read his books? (1 mark)

3. How much did the strawberry cost at the garden market? (1 mark)

4. Who did Pip share his snack with? (1 mark)

5. Why do you think Pip and Max felt happy at the end of the story? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Pip the caterpillar and Max the monkey sharing a snack in the garden. Don't forget to draw the big oak leaf where Pip keeps his books!



Extension challenge: Imagine you are Pip. If you had £1 to spend at the garden market, what other healthy snack would you buy to share with your friends? Draw your snack and write a sentence about it.
