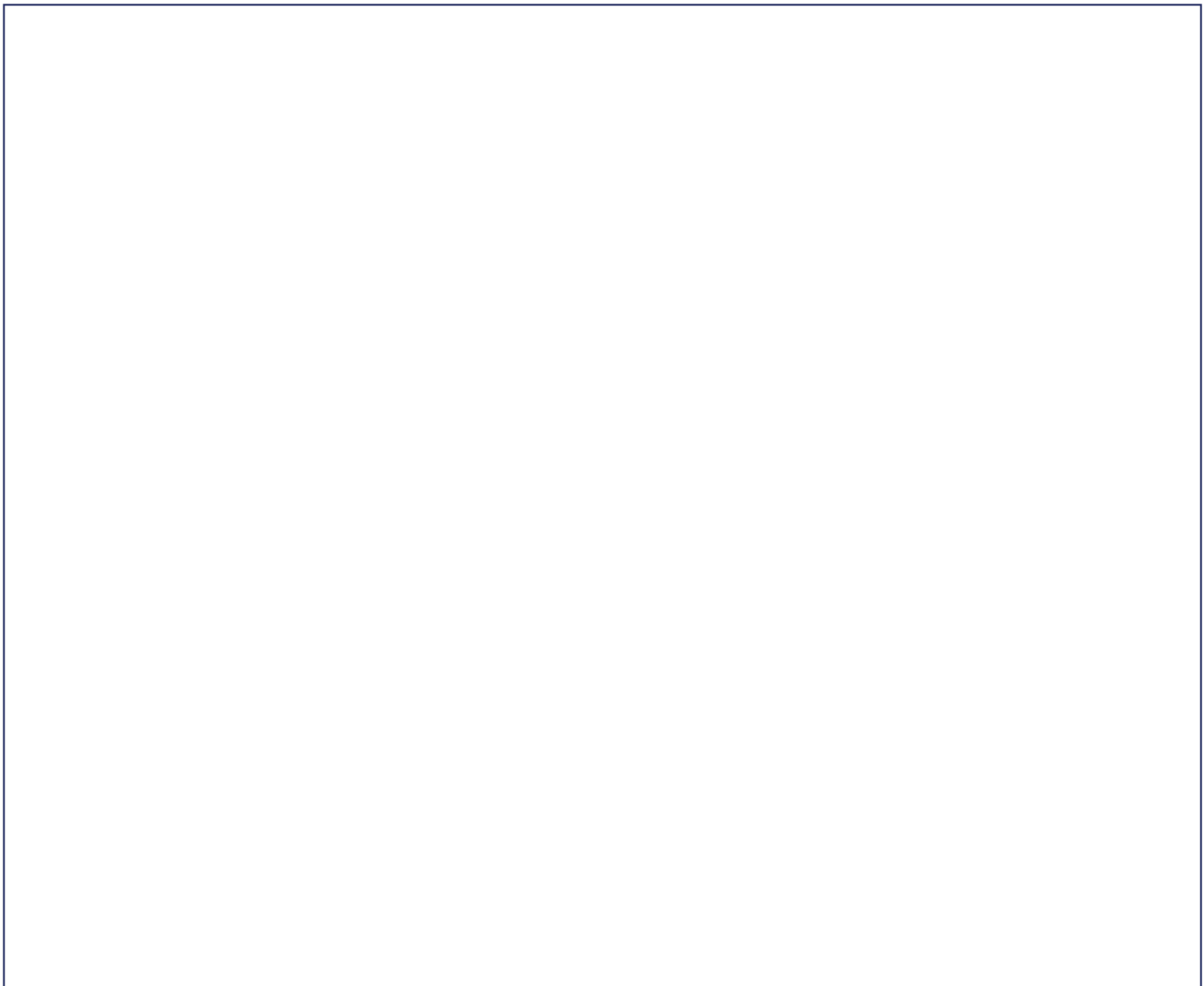


Pip the Caterpillar's Reading Nook

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of a story setting and characters through drawing and labelling.

Read the story description below. Use the information to draw Pip's cosy reading corner. Label your drawing using the words from the word bank to show you know where everything is!

Draw: Draw a scene featuring Pip the caterpillar sitting in a reading nook. Include a large leaf overhead, a small bookshelf, a red cushion, and a glowing lantern. Use bright, cheerful colours. Ensure Pip is clearly visible as a happy, smiling caterpillar.



Label words: caterpillar · bookshelf · cushion · lantern · leaves

Steps:

1. Who is the main character in the story?
2. What does Pip use to help him see his books in the dark?
3. Draw a line to connect the word 'cushion' to the object in your picture.
4. Why do you think Pip likes to read under a leaf?
5. What is one other thing you would add to Pip's reading nook to make it cosy?
