- A sentence must always start with a capital letter to show where it begins.
- Every sentence needs a full stop at the end to show it is finished.
- Remember to use finger spaces between your words so they do not squish together.
- A sentence should make sense when you read it aloud.
- Check your work: Capital letter at the start, full stop at the end!
