Learning objective: To practise spelling common exception words and words with suffixes -ment, -ness, -ful, and -less.

3. 3. Which word in the word bank is an antonym (the opposite) of 'careful'? (1 mark)

4. 4. Find a word in the passage that ends in -ment. Write it down and underline the suffix. (1 mark)

5. 5. Why did Max ask Pip for help with his spelling? (2 marks)
