Learning objective: To practise common Year 3 spelling patterns, including prefixes, suffixes, and homophones.

Read the front of each card to test your spelling knowledge. Flip the card mentally (or check the answer provided) to see if you are correct. Pip the Bookworm wants to see how many you can get right!

What is the correct spelling for the word meaning to vanish?	Add the prefix 're-' to 'appear' to make a new word.
disappear	reappear
Spell the word that means the thing you like the most (British English spelling).	Which word is a noun: 'breath' or 'breathe'?
favourite	breath
Which word is a verb: 'breath' or 'breathe'?	Spell the word that describes a line that is not curvy.
breathe	straight
How much does an object weigh? Spell the word for the measurement of heaviness.	Spell the number that comes after seven.
weight	eight
Spell the conjunction that means 'even though'.	What is the past tense of 'think'?
although	thought
