

Max's Maths-Spelling Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and correct common spelling errors, including homophones and words with silent letters, as expected for Year 5.

Max the monkey has been busy calculating costs for his jungle shop, but he has made some spelling mistakes in his receipts! Read the sentences below. Each sentence contains one misspelt word from the word bank. Circle the error, then write the correct spelling on the line provided.

Word bank: definite · accommodate · necessary · rhythm · separate · especially · sincerely

1. 1. Max needs to purchase a definatue number of bananas for the shop display. Correct spelling: (2 marks)

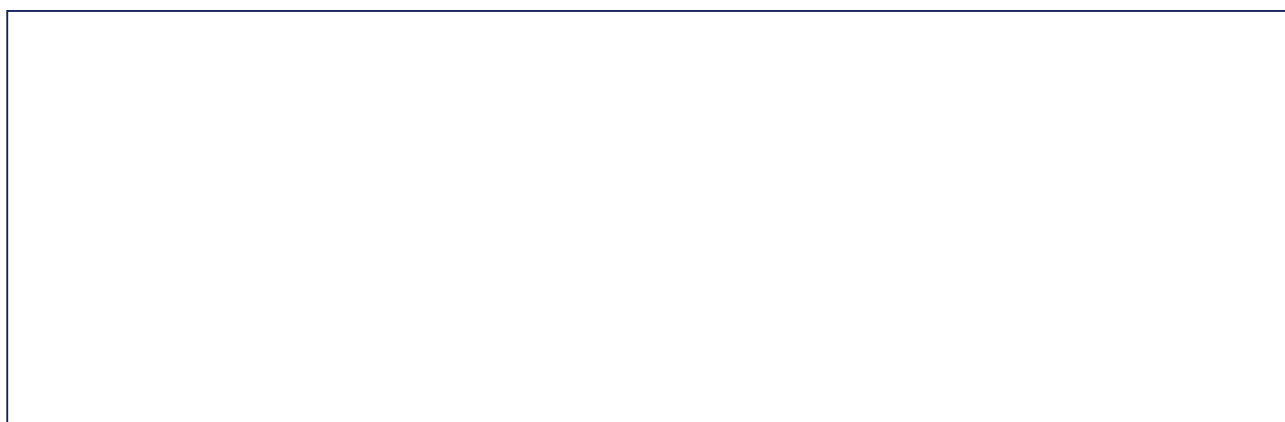
2. 2. It is acommodate to keep the fruit fresh in the wooden crates. Correct spelling: (2 marks)

3. 3. A steady rythm is needed when counting the coins at the end of the day. Correct spelling: (2 marks)

4. 4. Please ensure the apples and oranges are kept in seperate baskets. Correct spelling: (2 marks)

5. 5. It is neccessary to label the prices clearly in Australian dollars and cents. Correct spelling: (2 marks)
