

Year 5 Spelling Challenge: Mastering Tricky Words

Learning objective: To practise spelling common Year 5/6 statutory words and understand spelling rules, including silent letters and suffix patterns.

Use these flashcards to test your spelling skills. Read the front of the card, attempt to spell the word or answer the challenge, then flip to check your work. Ask Pip the caterpillar for help if you get stuck!

How do you spell the word that means 'to provide space for someone'?	Spell the word for something very old.
Accommodate (Remember: two c's and two m's!)	Ancient
Complete the spelling: Con_ _ _ _ _ e. This word means your sense of right and wrong.	Spell the word meaning to be provided with the necessary items for a task.
Conscience	Equipped
Spell the word that means a formal promise or assurance.	Spell the word for the fibrous tissue in your body that helps you move.
Guarantee	Muscle
Spell the word for someone who lives next door to you.	Spell the word meaning to reside in or fill a space.
Neighbour	Occupy
Spell the word for a line of people waiting for their turn.	Spell the word for words that have the same ending sound.
Queue	Rhyme
Spell the word for a member of an army.	Spell the word for a machine used for transporting people or goods.
Soldier	Vehicle
