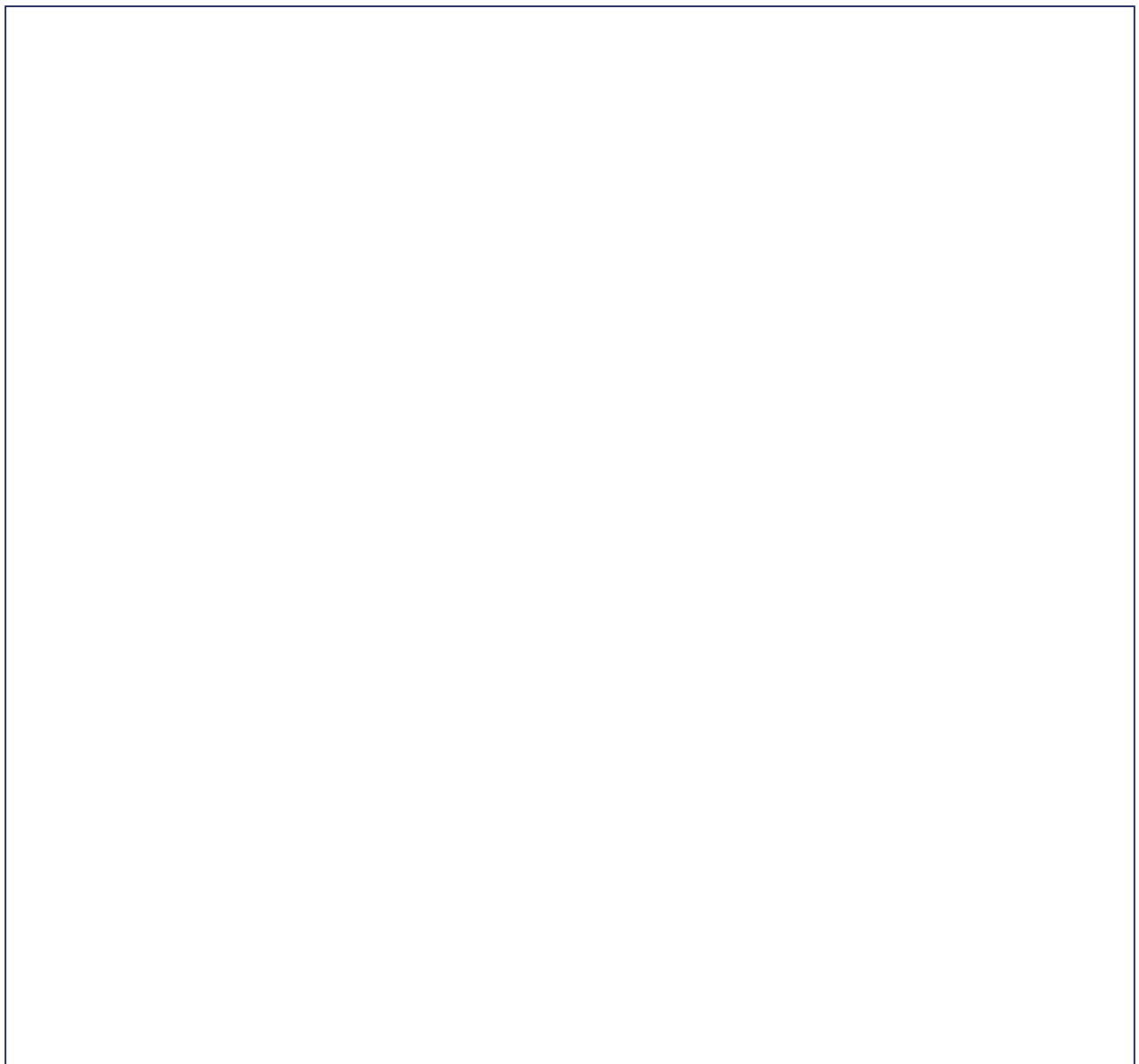


Pip's Storytime Adventure

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills through colouring and to engage with the concept of storytelling as a foundation for literacy.

Use your favourite colouring pencils or crayons to bring Pip's library to life. Think about what colours you would use for the books on the shelves and Pip the caterpillar!

Colour this: A friendly, cheerful caterpillar named Pip sitting on a large, open storybook. Pip is wearing round spectacles and has a happy smile. Around Pip, there is a cosy library setting: a tall wooden bookshelf filled with books of different sizes and shapes (some thick, some thin). In the corner, there is a soft, fluffy cushion and a small table with a jug of water. The lines should be bold and clear for easy colouring. Include a few floating stars and a quill pen near the book to suggest the magic of writing stories.



Steps:

1. Label the book that Pip is reading.
2. Label the shelf where the other stories are kept.
