

Storytime Adventures with Pip

Learning objective: To identify key elements of a story including characters, settings, and the beginning, middle, and end.

Help Pip the bookworm caterpillar organise his favourite stories. Read the questions and think about the stories you have heard in class.

Pip the bookworm loves to collect words from all the stories he reads. Every story needs someone to be in it, somewhere for them to go, and something exciting to happen!

Word bank: Character · Setting · Beginning · Middle · End · Problem · Adventure

1. Who is the main person or animal in your favourite story? This is called a character. (2 marks)

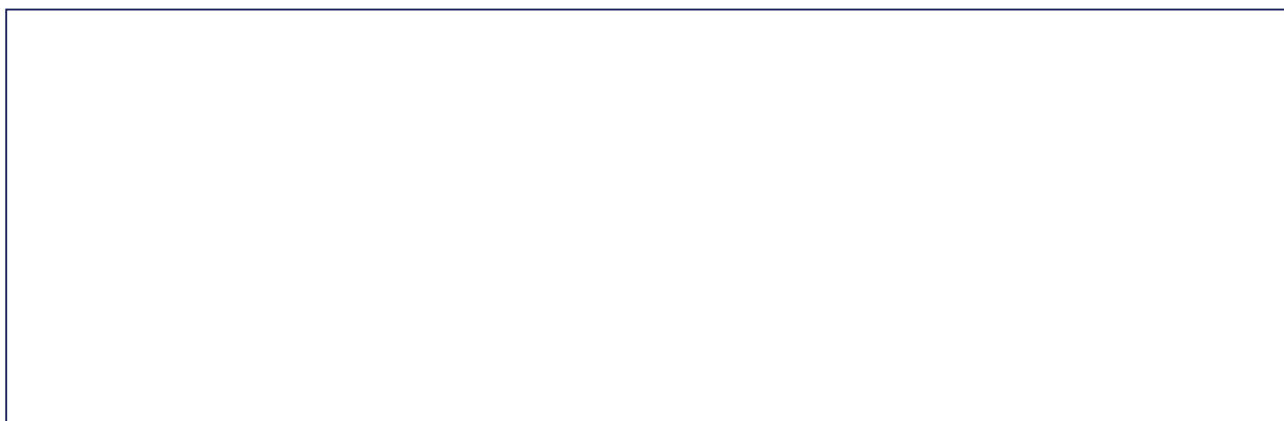
2. Where does your favourite story take place? Is it in a forest, a castle, or under the sea? (2 marks)

3. Draw a line to match the story part: The start is the... (1 mark)

4. What is the most exciting thing that happens in the middle of a story? (2 marks)

5. How do you know when a story has finished? What happens at the end? (2 marks)
