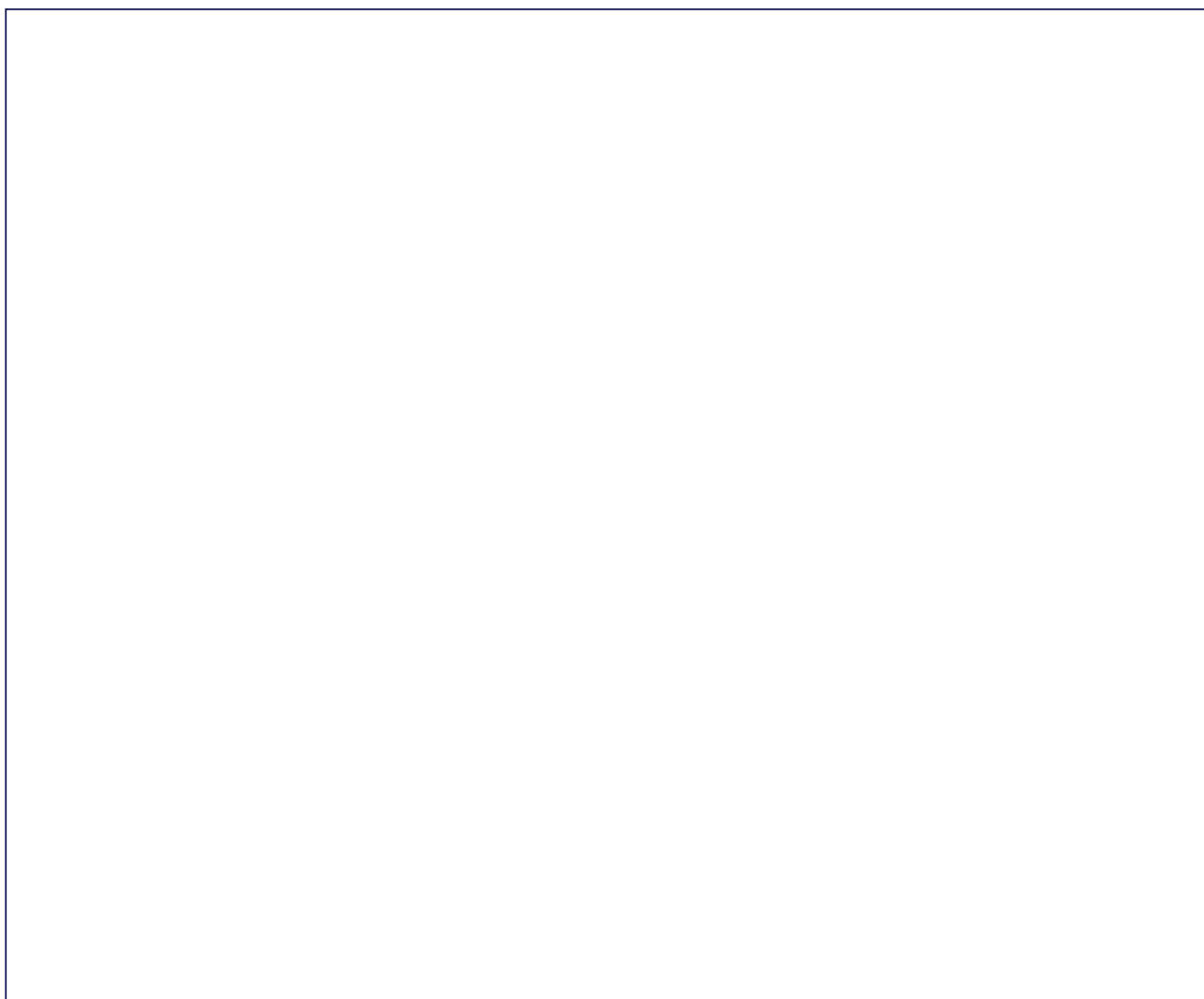


Pip the Caterpillar's Word Garden

Learning objective: To develop vocabulary by associating descriptive words with objects and illustrating them in a creative context.

Help Pip the caterpillar collect new words! Look at the word bank below. Choose three words to draw inside Pip's garden. Use your best artistic skills to show what the words mean.

Draw: Draw a bright, cheerful garden scene. In the centre, draw Pip, a friendly caterpillar with a big smile. Around Pip, create space to draw items that represent the adjectives from the word bank (e.g., a massive pumpkin for 'gigantic', a soft cloud for 'fluffy'). Use bold lines and bright colours. Ensure there is room near each object to write a label.



Label words: sparkly · gigantic · tiny · fluffy · colourful · bumpy

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Pip the caterpillar in the middle of your page. Make Pip look happy.
2. Step 2: Choose one word from the word bank. Draw an object that fits this word next to Pip. Label your drawing.
3. Step 3: Choose a second word from the word bank. Draw something else for Pip's garden that fits this word. Label your drawing.
4. Step 4: Think of a word to describe how Pip is feeling. Write or draw it in a speech bubble coming from

Pip.

5. Step 5: Add a 'bumpy' leaf or a 'sparkly' flower to the garden. Why did you choose those words?
