*Learning objective: To develop vocabulary by identifying, grouping, and using descriptive words to describe objects and emotions.*

*Word bank: sparkly · gigantic · happy · tiny · bright · sad · soft · woolly*

**1. Pip found a word that means 'very big'. Can you find it in the word bank and write it here? (1 mark)**

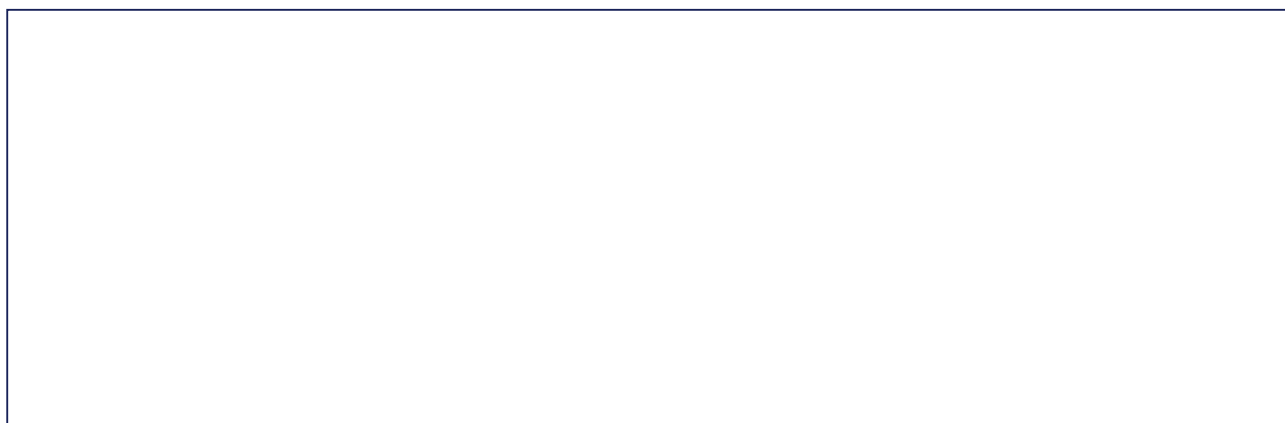
**2. Look at the words 'happy' and 'sad'. These are feeling words. Can you draw a face next to each one to show what they mean? (2 marks)**

**3. Which word from the list would you use to describe a fluffy sheep? Write it below. (1 mark)**

**4. Choose one word from the bank. Use it in a short sentence to describe something you saw at the park today. (2 marks)**

**5. If Pip has a tiny button that costs £1, and he finds a gigantic button that costs £2, which button is the most expensive? (1 mark)**
