4. Why is this toy special to you? Start with: I love this toy because... (2 marks)

5. Can you use one 'wow' word to describe how your toy moves or acts? Start with: My toy can... (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add a sentence using the word 'because' to explain what you would do if you took your toy on an adventure with Pip?
