

World Book Day: My Favourite Story Adventure

Learning objective: To use descriptive language to label a drawing and demonstrate comprehension of story settings and character traits.

Read the labels in the word bank and add them to your drawing to show the different parts of your magical book world. Use your best handwriting!

Draw: Draw a large, open book in the centre of the page. From the pages of the book, draw your story coming to life! Include a main character, a special setting, and at least one magical item. Use bright colours and clear lines to show the details of the world you have created.



Label words: enchanted forest · brave hero · glowing map · mysterious cave · hidden treasure · sparkling stream

Steps:

1. Choose one character from your drawing. Write two adjectives to describe their personality.
2. Where does your story take place? Write a full sentence to describe the setting.
3. If you could visit any book world, which one would you choose and why?
4. Label your drawing using at least three words from the word bank provided.
5. What is the most exciting object in your picture? Explain why it is important to the story.
