

World Book Day Celebration Flashcards

Learning objective: To understand the purpose of World Book Day, identify different genres, and explore the parts of a book.

Read the front of each card to learn about World Book Day. Test yourself by covering the answer side to see if you can remember the definition or fact.

What is World Book Day?

A special day celebrated every year to encourage children to enjoy books and reading.

Who is an author?

The person who writes the words in a book.

Who is an illustrator?

The person who draws the pictures or creates the artwork for a book.

What is a 'genre'?

A type of book, such as a mystery, a fairy tale, or a book about space.

What is 'fiction'?

A story that is made up from an author's imagination.

What is 'non-fiction'?

A book that gives real facts and information about the world.

What is a 'blurb'?

The short description on the back of a book that tells you what the story is about.

What is the 'setting' of a story?

The place and time where the story happens.

Who is Pip the Bookworm?

A cheerful caterpillar who loves collecting new words and reading stories.

What is a 'plot'?

The series of events that happen in a story from the beginning to the end.

Where is a great place to borrow books for free?

A library.

Why do we dress up for World Book Day?

To celebrate our favourite stories and share our love of reading with others.
