Learning objective: To develop comprehension skills, expand vocabulary, and practise creative writing based on the theme of World Book Day.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you with your spelling. Write your answers in full sentences where possible.

1. Why do you think Pip the bookworm enjoys visiting the library on World Book Day? (2 marks)

2. If you were going to dress up as a character from a book for World Book Day, who would you choose and why? (2 marks)

3. Find two adjectives in the word bank that could describe a brilliant story. (2 marks)

4. If a book costs £5 and a bookmark costs £2, how much would you spend altogether? (2 marks)

5. Write a sentence explaining why it is important to look after our books. (2 marks)
