

Year 4 French Assessment: Les Parties du Corps (The Body)

Learning objective: To identify and write the names of body parts in French and describe physical features.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in French where indicated. Rosa the Parrot is here to help you remember your vocabulary!

Rosa the parrot is looking at a picture of her friend, Leo the lion. Rosa says: 'Regardez Leo! Il a une grande tête et quatre pattes. Ses yeux sont marron.'

Word bank: la tête (head) · le bras (arm) · la jambe (leg) · le pied (foot) · le nez (nose) · les yeux (eyes) · les oreilles (ears) · la bouche (mouth) · les cheveux (hair) · bleu (blue) · marron (brown) · vert (green)

1. Translate the following body parts into French: 1. Head, 2. Nose, 3. Arm, 4. Leg. (4 marks)

2. Using the word bank, identify which body part is plural in French (hint: look for the word that starts with 'les'). (2 marks)

3. If someone says 'J'ai mal à la tête', what part of the body are they hurting? Explain your answer in English. (3 marks)

4. Look at the phrase 'Les yeux marron'. Translate this into English and explain why the adjective comes after the noun in French. (4 marks)

5. Translate: 'I have two eyes and a nose.' (3 marks)

6. Extended Writing Task: Describe yourself or a friend in French. You must include at least four body parts and two colours (e.g., 'J'ai les cheveux marron et les yeux vert'). (9 marks)

Draw: Draw a funny monster. Label at least four of its body parts using the correct French vocabulary from your word bank.
