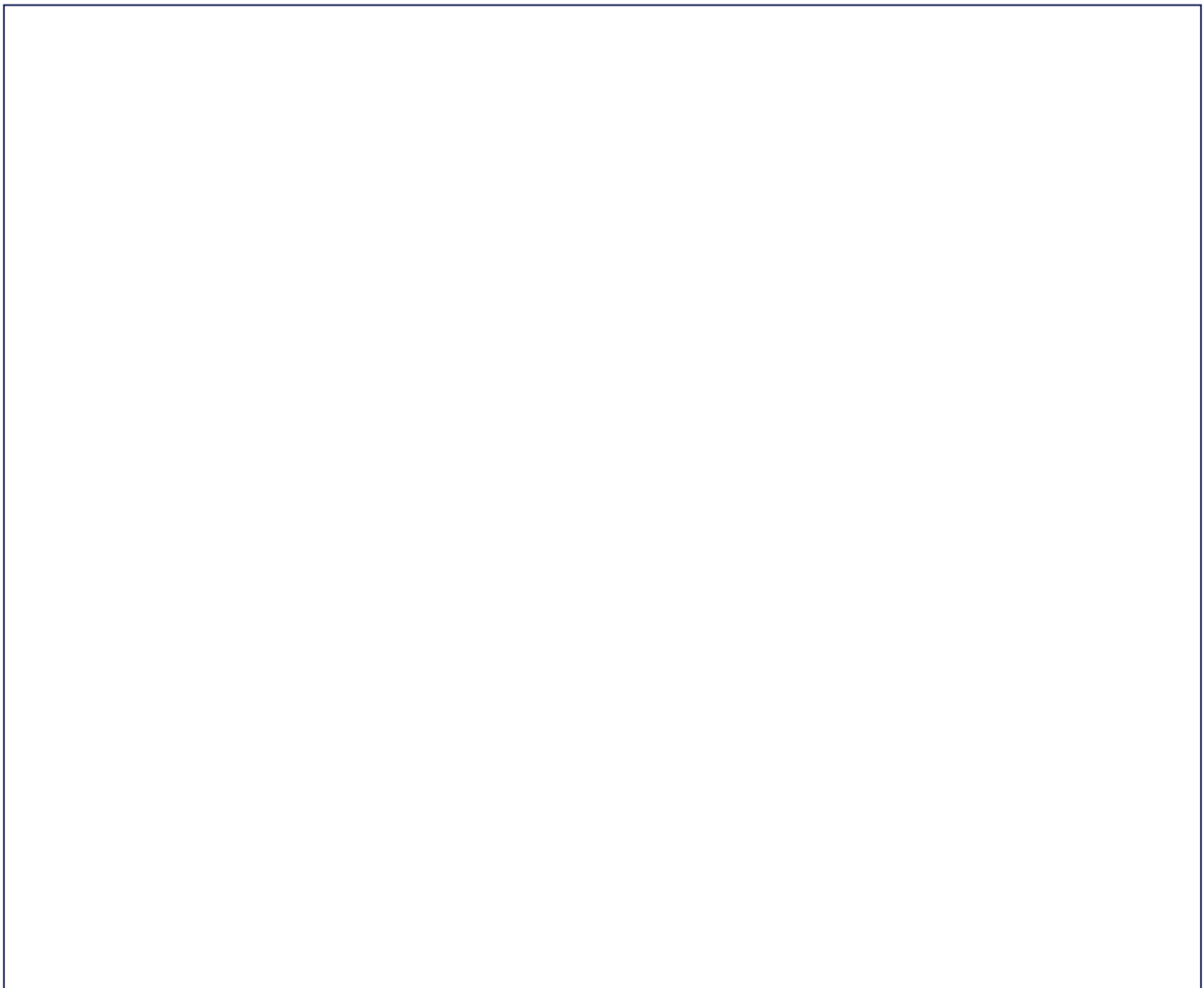


# Rosa's Body Parts Art Challenge

*Learning objective: To identify and label key parts of the human body in French.*

Follow Rosa the parrot's instructions to draw a friendly character. Once your drawing is complete, use the word bank to label the body parts in French. Make sure your labels are clear and easy to read!

**Draw:** Create a large, clear character in the middle of your paper. Use a simple, clean art style with bold outlines. Ensure there is plenty of white space around the character to write your labels. You may add a fun background, such as a park or a classroom, but keep the character's limbs and head distinct so the labels are easy to connect with lines.



*Label words: la tête · le bras · la main · la jambe · le pied · le ventre · le dos*

## Steps:

1. Draw a happy character in the centre of the page. Once drawn, label 'la tête' (the head) and 'le ventre' (the tummy).
2. Draw two arms and two hands on your character. Label 'le bras' and 'la main'.
3. Draw two legs and two feet. Label 'la jambe' and 'le pied'.
4. Draw your character facing away from us so we can see their back. Label 'le dos'.
5. Which French word from the word bank means 'the arm'? Write it here.
