

Rosa's French Body Parts Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for parts of the body in the context of a personal fact-file.

Help Rosa the parrot describe herself! Use the word bank provided to complete the fact-file in French. Remember to use the correct articles (le, la, les) where needed. You can find the English translations in your textbook or dictionary to help you match the words to the right body parts.

Word bank: la tête · le bras · la jambe · le pied · la main · les yeux · le nez · la bouche

1. Ma Tête (My Head): Identify the French word for head and describe one feature on your face using a simple adjective. (2 marks)

2. Mes Bras et Mes Mains (My Arms and Hands): Write the French words for arm and hand. How many hands do you have? Write the answer in French. (2 marks)

3. Mes Jambes et Mes Pieds (My Legs and Feet): Write the French words for leg and foot. Which body part do you use to kick a football? (2 marks)

4. Rosa's Observation: Rosa has feathers, but you have skin. Write a sentence in French about your 'nez' (nose) or 'bouche' (mouth). (2 marks)

5. Sentence Building: Combine two body parts into a sentence. For example: 'J'ai deux pieds' (I have two feet). (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you label a full-body drawing of yourself using at least eight different French body parts? Add a label for each one.
