

Rosa's Weekly French Calendar Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and order the days of the week in French, and use them within simple sentences.

Rosa the parrot is trying to plan her busy week of singing lessons. However, her feathers got ruffled and the days of the week have become mixed up! Follow the clues to help Rosa sequence her diary. First, write the correct French day next to its English meaning. Then, use the word bank to complete the sequence and answer the questions.

Word bank: lundi · mardi · mercredi · jeudi · vendredi · samedi · dimanche

1. Rosa starts her week on Monday. Write the seven days of the week in French in the correct order, starting with Monday (lundi). (7 marks)

2. If today is 'mercredi', what will be the day tomorrow? Write your answer in French. (1 mark)

3. Rosa has a singing lesson on 'samedi' and 'dimanche'. What do we call these two days in English? (2 marks)

4. Complete this sentence: 'Aujourd'hui, c'est...' (Today is...). Pick any day of the week and write it in French. (1 mark)

5. Rosa says, 'Je chante le vendredi.' Based on your knowledge, translate Rosa's sentence into English. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a colourful calendar for Rosa. In each box for the seven days, draw a small symbol to represent what Rosa might do that day (e.g., a musical note for singing, a book for reading, or a sun for a sunny day). Label each box with the correct French day.



Extension challenge: Can you write a short French sentence about what you do on a specific day? For example: 'Le samedi, je joue au football' (On Saturday, I play football). Use a dictionary to find one new verb to add to your sentence!
