

Rosa's French Food Feast: Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of French food vocabulary, identifying healthy choices, and expressing preferences using key phrases.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell your French vocabulary correctly. Write your answers in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a French market. She sees a basket full of fresh fruit, a loaf of crusty bread, and some creamy cheese. She needs to decide what to have for her lunch and what she wants to avoid.

Word bank: le pain · la pomme · les fraises · le fromage · l'eau · le chocolat · j'aime · je n'aime pas · délicieux · sain

1. Translate the following words into English: 1. Le pain, 2. La pomme. (2 marks)

2. Rosa wants to buy strawberries and cheese. Write these two items in French using the correct articles (le/la/les). (2 marks)

3. If Rosa likes chocolate but does not like water, write two sentences in French expressing these opinions. (4 marks)

4. Identify one item from the word bank that is considered 'sain' (healthy) and explain why in one English sentence. (4 marks)

5. Rosa is making a shopping list. Create a list of 4 items she might buy for a picnic. Include the French name and the English translation for each. (4 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Write a short paragraph (4-5 sentences) in French describing what you like to eat for your lunch. Include at least two food items and explain if you think they are 'délicieux' or not. (5 marks)

7. Give one example of a French food item that is NOT in the word bank and write its name. (4 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a 'pique-nique' basket filled with three healthy French food items you have learned today.
