

Rosa's French Food Feast

Learning objective: To learn and apply French vocabulary for common food items and express likes and dislikes using 'J'aime' and 'Je n'aime pas'.

Read each question carefully and use the word bank to help you complete the sentences. Ensure you use the correct articles (le, la, les, un, une) where appropriate.

Word bank: le pain · la pomme · les fraises · le chocolat · le fromage · le jus d'orange · J'aime · Je n'aime pas

1. Rosa the parrot is having a picnic. Translate these three food items into French: The bread, the apple, and the strawberries. (3 marks)

2. If Rosa loves cheese, how would she write that in a full French sentence? (2 marks)

3. If Rosa dislikes orange juice, write the French sentence to express this. (2 marks)

4. Look at the word 'chocolat'. Is it a masculine or feminine noun in French? Explain how you can tell by looking at the article. (2 marks)

5. Create a menu for your own picnic. List two items you like ('J'aime') and one item you do not like ('Je n'aime pas') using full French sentences. (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a French picnic basket filled with the items from the word bank.
Label each item in French.



Extension challenge: Research the names of three more fruits in French and write a sentence for each, describing whether you like them or not.
