

Rosa's French Greetings Adventure

Learning objective: To use and apply a range of French greetings and polite phrases appropriate for different times of the day and social contexts.

Help Rosa the parrot learn to greet her friends! Read each scenario carefully and select the most suitable French phrase from the word bank to respond, ensuring your spelling is accurate.

Word bank: Bonjour · Salut · Bonsoir · Au revoir · Comment ça va? · Ça va bien, merci · Enchanté · S'il vous plaît

1. Rosa meets a new friend in the park for the first time. She wants to say 'Nice to meet you'. Which phrase should she use? (1 mark)

2. It is 8:00 PM and the sun has set. You are saying goodbye to your neighbour before going inside. Which greeting is most appropriate and why? (3 marks)

3. Compare 'Bonjour' and 'Salut'. In what context would you use one over the other? Justify your choice based on formality. (3 marks)

4. If a friend asks you 'Comment ça va?', how would you respond if you were feeling very happy? Write your answer in French. (2 marks)

5. Explain why it is important to choose the correct time-based greeting in French. What might happen if you used 'Bonsoir' at 9:00 AM? (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a scene where Rosa the parrot is meeting a new friend in a garden. Include a speech bubble for Rosa that contains one of the greetings from our word bank.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are writing a script for a play featuring Rosa. Write a three-line dialogue between Rosa and Pip the caterpillar where they meet, ask how they are, and politely say goodbye. Use at least four phrases from the word bank.
