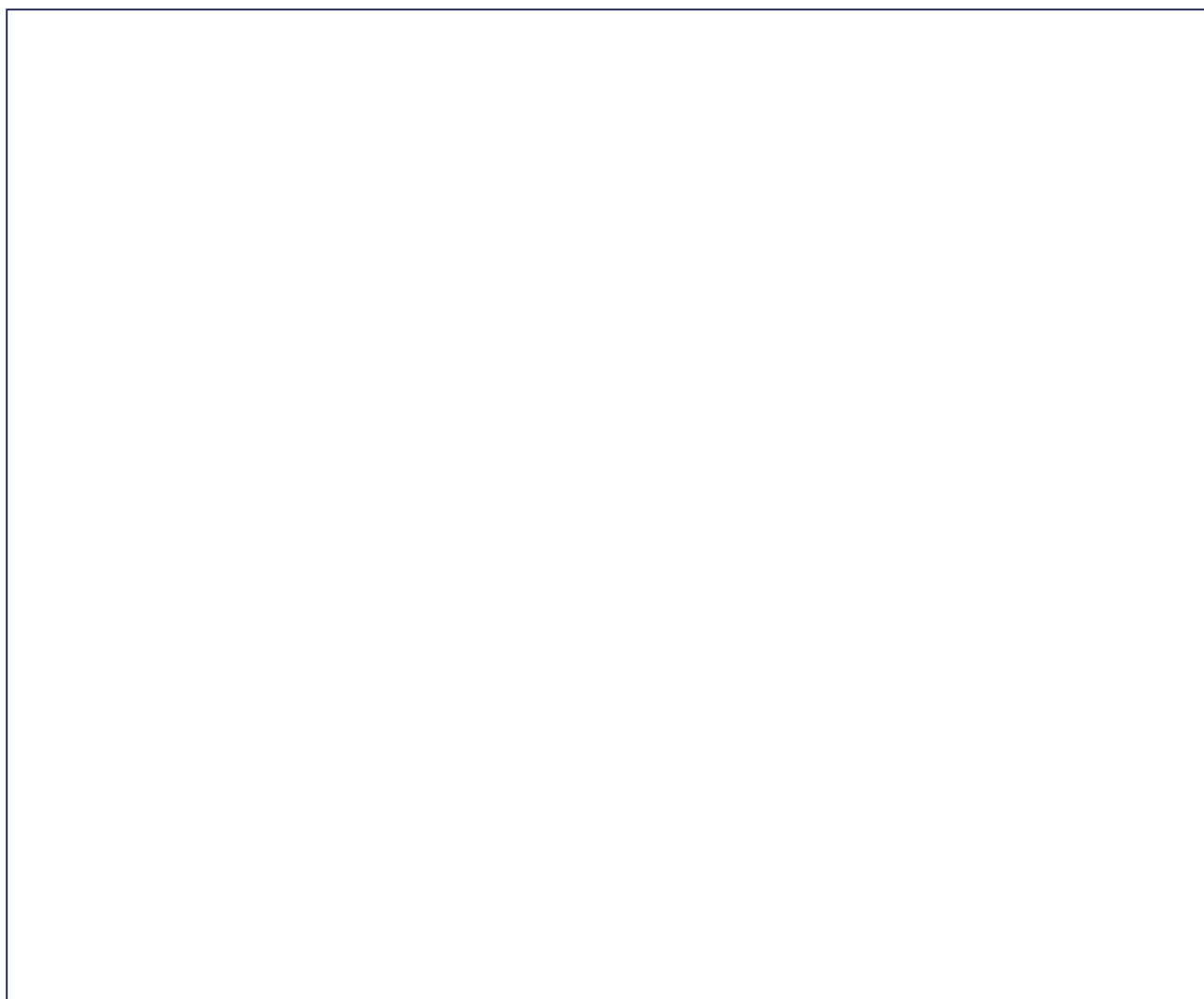


Rosa's Seasonal Calendar Illustration

Learning objective: To recall and spell the twelve months of the year in French and represent them visually through seasonal artistic expression.

Rosa the parrot has asked for your help to create a visual calendar. Follow the drawing prompt to illustrate the changing seasons. Once you have drawn your scene, label the months in French using the word bank provided.

Draw: Create a large circle divided into four equal segments to represent the four seasons. In each segment, draw a landscape that captures the essence of that time of year (e.g., snow for winter, flowers for spring). Around the outside of the circle, neatly print the three French months that belong to each season. Use vibrant colours and ensure your handwriting is clear. Add a small drawing of Rosa the parrot in the corner wearing a party hat.



Label words: janvier · février · mars · avril · mai · juin · juillet · août · septembre · octobre · novembre · décembre

Steps:

1. Label the four seasons in French around your drawing (le printemps, l'été, l'automne, l'hiver).
2. Explain why the French word for August ('août') might be more difficult to pronounce than the others.

Consider the silent letters.

3. If your birthday is in October, write a full sentence in French explaining this: 'Mon anniversaire est en...'
4. Compare and contrast the weather in 'juillet' with 'janvier'. Use French vocabulary for weather if you know any (e.g., il fait chaud / il fait froid).
5. Justify your answer: Which month is the most significant for your personal celebrations and why?
6. What might happen if the calendar only had six months instead of twelve? How would this affect the seasons?
