

Rosa's French Cafe: Expressing Opinions

Learning objective: To use French opinion phrases (J'aime, Je n'aime pas, J'adore, Je déteste) to describe food and drink items.

Rosa the parrot is opening a cafe! Help her decorate the menu boards by drawing her favourite items and labelling them with the correct French opinion phrase.

Draw: Draw four square 'menu boards' on your page. In the first square, draw an ice cream cone and label it 'J'adore la glace'. In the second, draw a piece of cheese and label it 'J'aime le fromage'. In the third, draw some broccoli or carrots and label it 'Je n'aime pas les légumes'. In the fourth, draw a bar of chocolate and label it 'Je déteste le chocolat'. Use bright colours and draw Rosa the parrot at the top of the page wearing a chef's hat.

Label words: J'adore (I love) · J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I don't like) · Je déteste (I hate) · la glace (ice cream) · le chocolat (chocolate) · les légumes (vegetables) · le fromage (cheese)

Steps:

1. Write a sentence in French using 'J'adore' to say you love ice cream.
2. Which phrase would you use if you really disliked eating vegetables? Write it below.
3. Translate 'J'aime le fromage' into English.
4. If Rosa says 'Je déteste le chocolat', does she like it or dislike it?

5. Create your own French sentence using an opinion phrase and a food item of your choice.
