Master the art of expressing your opinion with Rosa the Parrot!

- Use 'J'adore' to show you have a very strong positive opinion about something.
- The phrase 'Je n'aime pas' is the perfect way to say you do not enjoy an activity.
- Always place your opinion phrase at the very start of your sentence.
- If you really dislike something, use 'Je déteste' to show it is your least favourite thing.
- Practice mixing and matching your opinion verbs with new hobbies you learn in class.

Did you know? Did you know? In French, when you say you like something, you usually add the word 'le', 'la', or 'l' before the noun! For example, instead of just saying 'I like football', you say 'J'aime le football'.

Key vocabulary: J'aime (I like) · J'adore (I love) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like) · Je déteste (I hate) · le chocolat (chocolate) · le football (football) · la musique (music)
