

French Opinion Phrases with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To learn and apply French phrases to express likes and dislikes using varied vocabulary.

Rosa the parrot is helping us express our opinions in French. Read the vocabulary list carefully, then answer the questions to show how you feel about different activities.

Rosa the parrot loves to chirp her opinions! To say what you like, start with your opinion phrase, add the activity, and then use 'parce que c'est' to explain why. For example: 'J'adore la lecture parce que c'est passionnant!'

Word bank: J'adore (I love) · J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like) · Je déteste (I hate) · le football (football) · la lecture (reading) · la natation (swimming) · le dessin (drawing) · les mathématiques (maths) · parce que c'est... (because it is...) · amusant (fun) · ennuyeux (boring) · passionnant (exciting) · difficile (difficult)

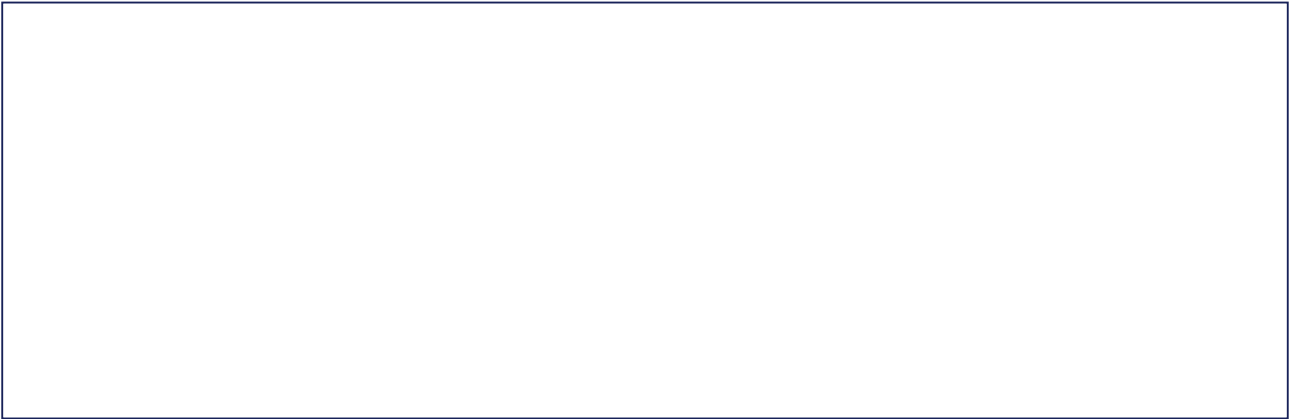
2. Write a French sentence expressing that you do not like swimming because it is difficult.
