Learning objective: To learn and apply French vocabulary related to shopping, prices, and polite requests in a retail context.

Use these flashcards to practise your French shopping vocabulary. Rosa the parrot suggests saying the phrases out loud to improve your pronunciation. Can you master the language of the market?

How do you ask 'How much does it cost?' in French?	Translate the phrase 'I would like' into French.
Combien ça coûte ?	Je voudrais
What is the polite French term for 'Please'?	Translate 'The shop' into French.
S'il vous plaît	Le magasin
How do you say 'Thank you' in French?	Translate the phrase 'It is expensive' into French.
Merci	C'est cher
What is the French phrase for 'It is cheap' or 'good value'?	How would you ask for 'a loaf of bread' politely?
C'est bon marché	Je voudrais un pain, s'il vous plaît
Translate the word 'change' (the money you get back) into French.	How do you say 'one pound' using the French currency equivalent?
La monnaie	Un euro
If a shop assistant says 'Voici la monnaie', what are they giving you?	Translate the sentence 'The fruit is not expensive.'
Here is your change	Le fruit n'est pas cher.
