

Rosa's French Market Adventure

Learning objective: To use French vocabulary and currency understanding to role-play shopping at a market.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a French market! Use the template below to plan your own shopping trip. Choose items you want to buy, decide how much they cost in pounds, and write your shopping phrases in French.

Word bank: Combien ça coûte ? · S'il vous plaît · Merci · Je voudrais · C'est combien ? · Le pain · La pomme · Le fromage · La carotte

1. Item Selection: What three items are you planning to buy at the market? Write them in English and their French equivalents. (3 marks)

2. The Price Tag: Choose a price for each of your three items using £ (Australian dollars and cents). Remember, prices must be realistic! (3 marks)

3. The Polite Request: Write a sentence in French using 'Je voudrais' (I would like) to ask for one of your chosen items. (2 marks)

4. The Total Cost: Calculate the total cost of all three items added together. Show your working out. (3 marks)

5. Closing the Deal: What phrase would you say in French to thank the shopkeeper after paying? (1 mark)

Extension challenge: Imagine you have a budget of £10.00. Create a new shopping list that stays under your budget and write a short dialogue between you and the shopkeeper in French.
