

Year 4 French Assessment: Les Sports

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of French vocabulary related to sports, express personal preferences using 'je joue au' and 'je fais de la', and identify sports in written French.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in the spaces provided. Remember to use the correct articles (au, à la, aux) where needed.

Rosa the parrot is busy at the school sports day. She loves to cheer for her friends! Leo the lion is playing football. Max the monkey is very good at tennis. Ellie the elephant is practising her swimming (la natation). Zara the zebra loves to dance (la danse).

3. Which sports use 'au' and which use 'de la'? Sort the following into the correct group: le football, la danse, le basket, le judo. (4 marks)

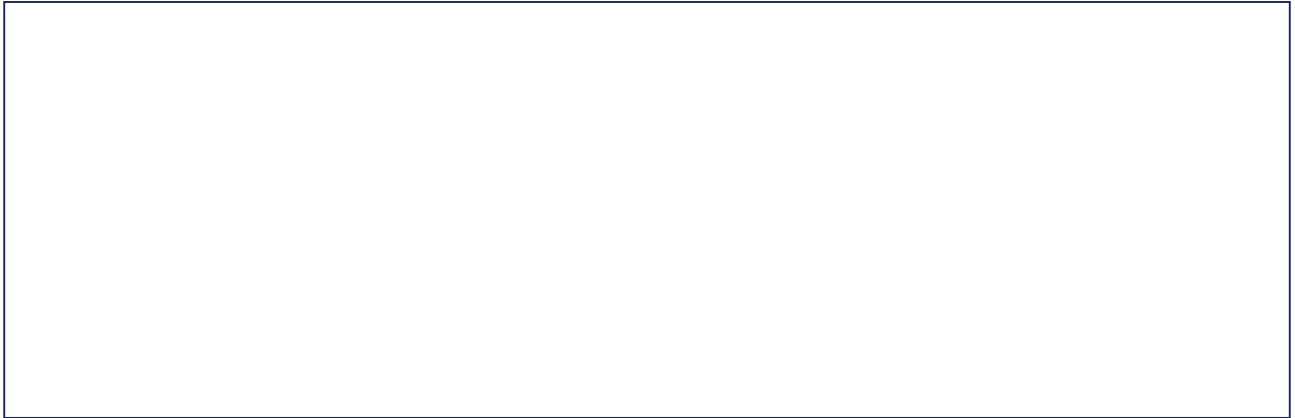
4. Max says: 'J'aime le football, mais je n'aime pas la danse.' Explain what Max is saying in your own words. (3 marks)

5. If Pip the caterpillar wanted to join a club, how would you ask him in French 'Do you play football?' and how might he reply if he loves it? (4 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Write a short paragraph (3-5 sentences) in French describing your favourite sport. Include why you like it or who you play it with using the vocabulary provided. (5 marks)

7. Look at the list of sports. Which ones are team sports and which are individual? Give one example of each in French. (6 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite sport in action. Label the sport in French (e.g., 'C'est le tennis').
