2. Translate the following sentence into English: 'Max adore jouer au football.' (2 marks) (2 marks)

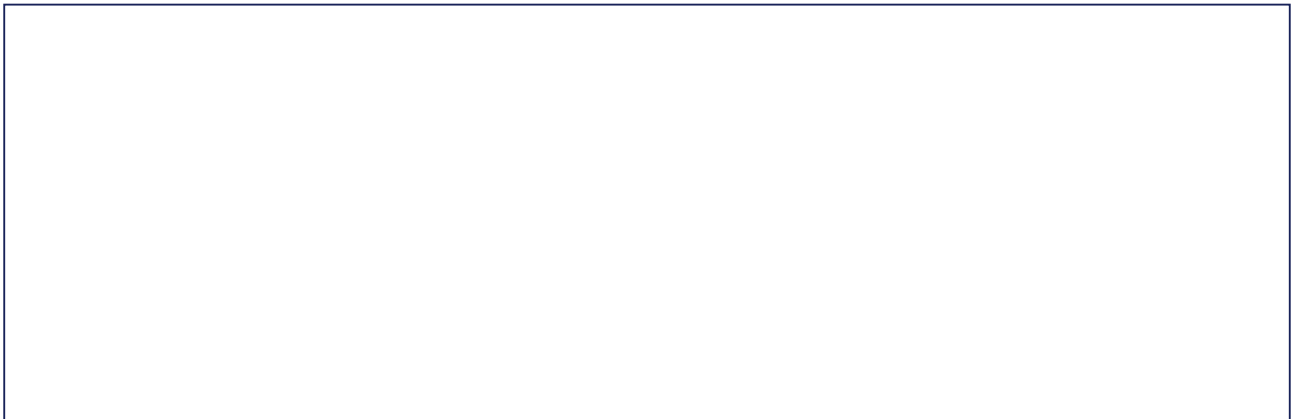
