

Rosa's French Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and use French vocabulary for different modes of transport by creating a labelled scene.

Follow the drawing prompt to create a scene showing different ways to travel. Use the word bank to label your vehicles in French.

Draw: Create a busy landscape drawing that includes a blue sky, a river, a road, and a railway track. In the sky, draw a plane. On the river, draw a boat. On the road, draw a car and a bus. Near the road, draw a person on a bicycle. By the railway track, draw a train. Ensure your drawing has enough space to write the French labels clearly next to each vehicle.



Label words: un vélo (a bicycle) · un train (a train) · une voiture (a car) · un bus (a bus) · un bateau (a boat) · un avion (a plane)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, colourful 'avion' in the sky and a 'bateau' on the water. Label them both in French.
2. Step 2: Draw a road with 'une voiture' and 'un bus' travelling along it. Label these vehicles.
3. Step 3: Draw a person riding 'un vélo' near a train station. Draw 'un train' at the station and label both.
4. Which of these modes of transport would you choose to travel to school? Write your answer in a full

French sentence starting with 'Je voyage en...'

5. If you wanted to travel across the ocean to see Finn the dolphin, which vehicle from the list would be the most sensible choice?
