

Rosa's French Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To recall and use French vocabulary for different types of transport and understand basic sentence structure in the context of travel.

Join Rosa the parrot on her journey across France! Read the questions carefully and use your French vocabulary knowledge to help Rosa find her way. Write your answers clearly.

Which do you think is more environmentally friendly and why? 3. Justify your choice: If you had £50 to travel across a French city, which transport would you choose and why? 4. What might happen if you tried to travel to a beach using only 'le train' and 'le vélo'? 5. Create a short, three-sentence French story about your dream holiday journey using at least two types of transport. 6. If you were designing a new, futuristic mode of transport for France, what would you name it in French and why?
