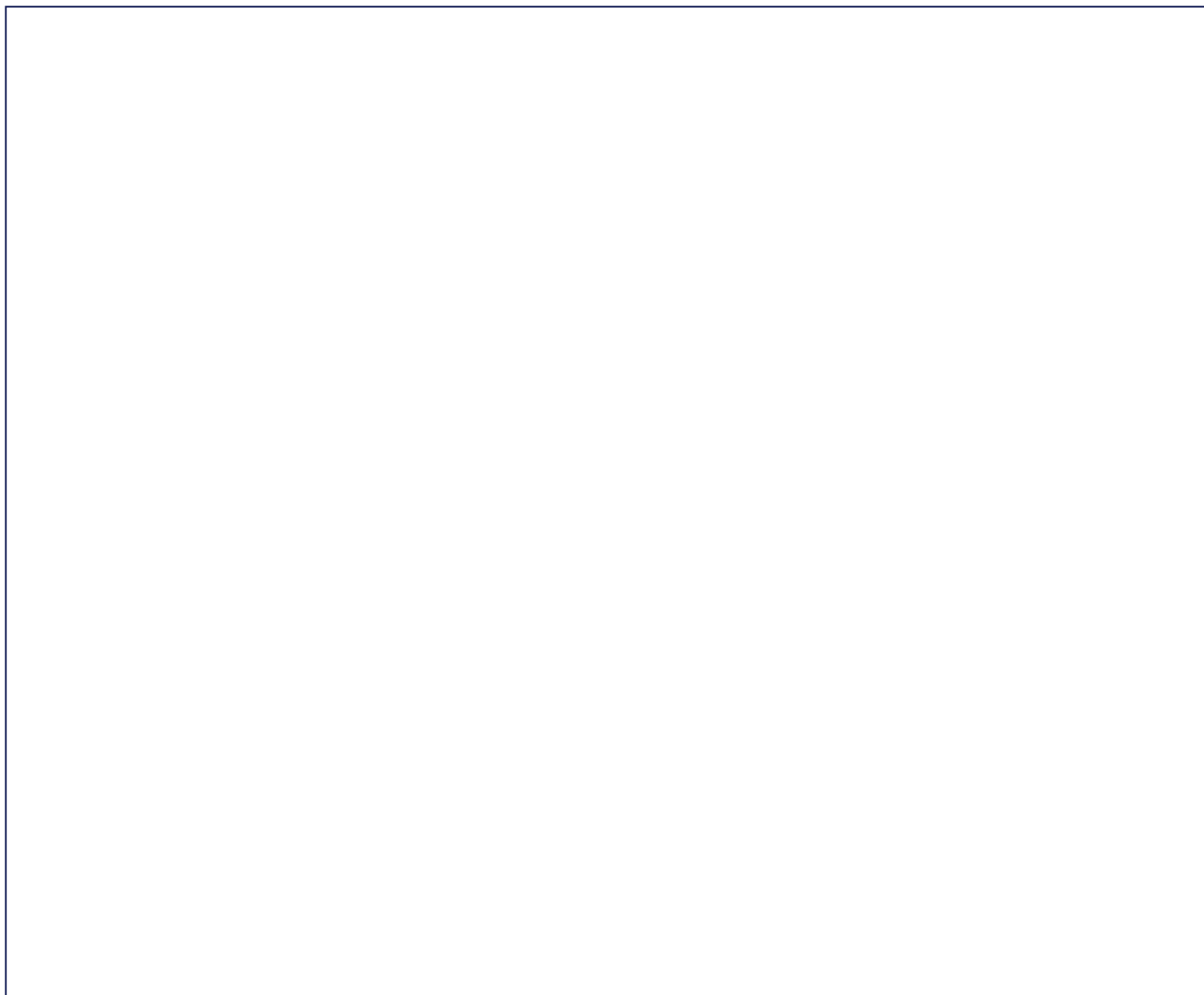


Rosa's French Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and label common modes of transport in French and illustrate them within a creative scene.

Rosa the parrot is ready to travel! Use the word bank to label the vehicles in your drawing. Make sure your labels are written clearly in French.

Draw: Create a bustling scene showing a journey. Include a road with a 'voiture' and a 'bus', a railway track with a 'train', and a river or sea with a 'bateau'. You may add an 'avion' in the sky above. Use bright colours and clear outlines so each vehicle can be easily labelled.



Label words: le vélo (bicycle) · la voiture (car) · le train (train) · le bus (bus) · l'avion (aeroplane) · le bateau (boat)

Steps:

1. Draw a scene featuring at least four different modes of transport from the word bank. Ensure each vehicle is clearly visible.
2. Label your four drawn vehicles using the correct French nouns from the word bank.
3. Which mode of transport would you choose to travel to France? Write your answer in French: 'Je voudrais voyager en...' followed by your chosen transport.
4. If a train ticket costs £12.50 and a bus ticket costs £4.25, how much would it cost for both?

5. Explain why you chose the specific colours you used for 'le train' in your drawing.
