

Rosa's Verbs and Tenses Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and use French verbs in the present tense, specifically focusing on common -er verbs like 'aimer' (to like) and 'habiter' (to live).

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends learn how to talk about what they do every day. Look at the French verbs in the word bank. Your task is to match the correct verb form to the English pronoun and sentence description. Write the correct French verb form in the box provided for each question.

Word bank: j'aime · tu aimes · il habite · elle habite · nous aimons · ils habitent

1. Rosa says: 'I like reading books.' Which phrase from the word bank matches 'I like'? (2 marks)

2. Max is asking his friend: 'Do you like maths?' Which phrase from the word bank matches 'you like'? (2 marks)

3. Finn is talking about his friend Leo. 'Leo lives by the sea.' Which phrase from the word bank matches 'he lives'? (2 marks)

4. Ellie is talking about her friend Zara. 'Zara lives in the forest.' Which phrase from the word bank matches 'she lives'? (2 marks)

5. Pip and Nova say together: 'We like looking at the stars.' Which phrase from the word bank matches 'we like'? (2 marks)

6. Kit and Bea are talking about their friends. 'They live in the garden.' Which phrase from the word bank matches 'they live'? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting on a branch holding a sign that says 'J'aime le français!' (I like French!), and decorate the background with things that you personally like, such as books, stars, or maths symbols.



Extension challenge: Try to write one new sentence in French about where you live, using the pattern: 'J'habite à...' (I live in...)
