

Quel temps fait-il ? (What is the weather like?)

Join Rosa the parrot as we fly across the globe to talk about the weather in French!

- To ask about the weather in French, we use the phrase 'Quel temps fait-il?'.
- When the sun is shining brightly, we say 'Il fait du soleil'.
- If you see raindrops falling from the clouds, you can say 'Il pleut'.
- When the temperature is high and you are wearing a t-shirt, it is 'Il fait chaud'.
- If the wind is blowing, use the phrase 'Il y a du vent'.
- During the winter months, if the ground turns white, we say 'Il neige'.

Did you know? Did you know? In France, the weather can vary greatly from the sunny beaches of the Mediterranean coast to the snowy peaks of the Alps! Rosa the parrot loves to practise her French while flying over these different landscapes, making sure she always knows whether to pack her sunglasses or her woolly scarf.
